

# Mildred Thompson

Mildred Thompson est née en 1936 à Jacksonville (Floride) et décédée en 2003 à Atlanta (Géorgie). Diplômée de l'Université Howard à Washington, DC en 1957, elle avait étudié auprès de l'historien de l'art afro-américain James A. Porter. Elle a travaillé en Europe (Allemagne et France) et aux États-Unis.

L'œuvre de Thompson a récemment été présentée dans l'exposition collective "Magnetic Fields: Expanding American Abstraction, 1960s to Today" au National Museum of Women in the Arts, Washington, DC, présentée ensuite au Kemper Museum of Contemporary Art, Kansas City, Missouri. En 2016, l'exposition personnelle "Resonance, Selected Works from the 1990s" s'est tenue au SCAD Museum of Art de Savannah (Géorgie). Des œuvres de Mildred Thompson se trouvent dans de nombreuses collections privées en Europe et aux États-Unis, notamment la collection d'art afro-américain de Larry et Brenda Thompson ainsi que la collection Mott-Warsh à Flint, Michigan. Elle figure aussi dans de nombreuses collections publiques: Brooklyn Museum, New York ; MoMA, New York; National Museum of Women in the Arts, Washington ; Musée d'art de la Nouvelle-Orléans, Louisiane; et le Smithsonian American Art Museum, Washington.
